Educational Center is named for the Claretian founder. It is sometimes known as the Institute.

For 15 years through many changes, TEACH has invested in the education of hundreds of students and also in infrastructure projects, many of those funded by St. Mary of Sorrows, in Fairfax, Va. Late in 2022, an opportunity for another partner came to our attention through one of our other schools.

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Fe y Alegria (Faith and Joy), an international Jesuit organization, works with the Guatemalan government. In 2023, they began some funding for Semuy teachers to provide schools in 57 rural areas, with the enthusiastic support of the community. Soon it was obvious that a new, larger school was needed and some nearby land was available. Negotiations began and continued throughout the school year. TEACH was asked and agreed to donate money to help purchase the use of the land for 25 years.

Fe y Alegria will run the school, and TEACH will continue to support a girls' dormitory and to offer scholarships for Semuy students to attend high school.

It is with great *joy* and a leap of *faith* that we announce the agreement signed on Nov. 10, 2023 between Fe y Alegria and the Semuy community. It is with great pride that we release this school, while we remain a solid partner in the community.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to witness this dream come true, for the education of many



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children and young people in the rural area of El Estor Izabal," said Brother Welfred Ruiz. "May God's providence continue to strengthen this valuable project. My best wishes for blessings to all TEACH partners who for many years have supported and made a presence with their contributions to the Semuy community."

Perhaps overshadowing this achievement is the sadness we feel for the hundreds of children suffering in areas of war. Guatemala has had its share of this suffering. We are called to make this world a better place in our little corner and are proud to do so with the support of dedicated volunteers and generous sponsors and donors. Indeed the lengthy, complex negotiations for this Faith and Joy project would not have been possible without our translators, Jeff Schneider, Jorge Perez, and Eduardo Padilla. Thank you.
